SPREADING MISINFORMATION

 Students can post or text unverified information, which can cause panic and hinder emergency response.

OVERLOADING NETWORKS

 Too many calls or texts at once can overload networks, making it hard for emergency services and school officials to communicate.

REVEALING LOCATIONS

 Sounds and texts/posts can expose hiding spots to an active threat.

4

DISTRACTING STUDENTS FROM INSTRUCTIONS

 Students focused on texting or recording can miss critical safety instructions from teachers or emergency responders.

5

CREATING PANIC AMONG PARENTS

 A flood of messages from students may cause parents to rush to the school, interfering with emergency vehicle arrival.
